## ***Green Initiatives at The Heldrich***

### **Currently...**

- ~Fluorescent bulbs are being used in areas that are not controlled by dimmers.
- ~Timers are used to control all exterior lighting as well as workforce public space lighting.
- ~All cardboard shipping containers received are sent for recycling.
- ~Waste paper is placed into recycling bins.
- ~All paints used in The Heldrich are environmentally friendly.
- ~Our air handling units, heating boilers, chillers, cooling towers, and numerous water circulating pumps have Variable Frequency Drives (VFD's), permitting units to run at decreased speeds with lower energy consumption.
- ~All toilets, guestroom shower heads and sink faucets utilize water saving technology.
- ~Laundry energy and water conservation are achieved by guests being asked to hang up towels for reuse. A sign located on the bed explains that if a guest places the sign on the bed, the sheet will be changed at their option.
- ~Plastic and aluminum bottles for liquids are properly recycled.
- ~Ceramic cups and plates are used at all of our break kiosks.
- ~Lighting Occupancy Sensors have been installed in seldom used areas
- ~HVAC units are on a timing schedule that shuts them off during the off peak time from 12am-5am.
- ~All public and guestroom bathrooms have recyclable C-fold towels and toilet tissue.
- ~Surplus paint is donated to the New Brunswick Charter School for their use.
